Update on Implementation of New Laws

BACKGROUND

The Regular Session of the 102nd General Assembly convened on Wednesday, January 4, 2023, and adjourned *sine die* on Friday, May 12, 2023. For bills passed during the session, the Governor has 15 days to sign or veto the bills. For bills passed and delivered to the Governor after a session has concluded, the Governor has 45 days to sign or veto the bills.

CURRENT STATUS

Laws passed that require implementation/action by the Department of Higher Education and Workforce Development:

- House Bill 3 – DHEWD Budget Bill
- House Bill 5 – ITSD Budget Bill
- House Bill 17 – Reappropriation Budget Bill
- House Bill 19 – Planning and Capital Projects
- House Bill 20 – ARPA Budget Bill
- House Bill 402 – Health Care
- House Bill 417 - Upskilling
