## **Information Submitted by Other Institutions**

### Mineral Area College

- Proposes to host the meeting in their new Industry and Technology Center. This facility was built using MOExcels funds. MAC would like the opportunity to showcase the project that the CBHE voted to fund.

### Missouri State University

- President Smart would like to host the event as one of his last acts as president.
- MSU would host the CBHE work session and board meeting in the Plaster Student Union. It's a flexible facility with easy access to parking. Rooms have A/V capabilities, access to phone lines, etc. We also have space to host COPHE and MCCA if they want to meet in connection with the board meeting.
- President Smart can host the evening social event at his home. He has space to accommodate the board, DHEWD staff, and members of the PAC.
- While DHEWD staff and the board will make their own hotel arrangements, we would recommend that everyone stay at the Hotel Vandivort in downtown Springfield. It's only about five minutes from campus and offers casual meeting spaces that allow for lots of informal interaction. There are plenty of dining options within easy walking distance of the hotel.

### Ozarks Technical College

- Ozarks Technical Community College's Robert W. Plaster Center for Advanced Manufacturing is dedicated to serving as the regional hub for all advanced manufacturing and technology-related education and training. This \$40 million investment is fully funded through both public and private contributions, with over \$12 million of MOExcels and state funding. The center's innovative footprint includes:
  - 120,000 square feet
  - 5 conference rooms available equipped for virtual meetings
  - 2,500 square foot event space
  - State of the art training equipment and facilities
  - Expansive (30,000 square foot) high bay configured for manufacturing.
    - Features manufacturing training and industry support in this space
    - Turn-key manufacturing space to support business incubation
    - Specialized hands-on learning environments
- OTC can offer ample small conference rooms and meeting spaces, as well as a large event space to accommodate the June 2023 meeting. Hotel accommodations and a reception would be hosted at the Hotel Vandivort. Located 5 minutes from campus, the

Vandivort offers an upscale boutique hotel experience with an in-house farm-to-table dining experience showcasing locally sourced ingredients, and a unique rooftop lounge offering shareable plates and local craft brews and cocktails.

#### St. Louis Community College

- Proposes to host the meeting in their new Nursing and Health Sciences Building at the downtown campus (Forest Park). This building is the design inspiration for identical buildings STLCC is building at its Wildwood and Ferguson campuses. STLCC is using MOExcels and ARPA funding for the two new buildings. Hosting the June 2024 meeting in the new Nursing and Health Sciences Building will serve as a great “preview” for what STLCC is doing with the MOExcels and ARPA funds.

#### University of Missouri – Columbia

- Proposes to host the CBHE in the new Roy Blunt NextGen Precision Health Complex. The institution would also like this opportunity to highlight their exceeding work with tours of the Nuclear Research Reactor and the Ag Experiment Stations.
