Executive Order Update

Coordinating Board for Higher Education
March 6, 2019

BACKGROUND

Section 26.500, RSMo, authorizes the governor to submit plans for the reorganization of executive agencies of state government within the first 30 days of any regular legislative session. Such plans take effect not sooner than 90 days after the final adjournment of the legislative session unless they are disapproved by a majority vote of either the House or the Senate.

Governor Mike Parson issued Executive Order 19-03 on January 17, 2019. The order proposes to move the Division of Workforce Development (DWD) and the Missouri Economic Research and Information Center (MERIC) from the Department of Economic Development to the Department of Higher Education (DHE). The order will take effect unless it is disapproved by March 18, 2019. In addition, the governor's budget put funding for DWD and MERIC into the Department of Higher Education's budget. Those funds will be in DHE's budget beginning July 1, 2019.

Finally, DHE's 2019 Blueprint Implementation Plan commits the department to work with staff, stakeholders, and board members to develop, communicate, and implement a vision for a 21st century Department of Higher Education.

CURRENT STATUS

Although the status of the governor's reorganization plan will not be known until March 18, 2019, department staff have begun work on developing a new vision to guide their work. A consulting firm will support that work by engaging with stakeholders, collecting and compiling feedback, and presenting a draft vision for the board's consideration at its June 5, 2019, board meeting. A new organizational chart and branding will be finalized by July 1, 2019.
