## Approved Dual Credit Provider List

Coordinating Board for Higher Education  
June 12, 2024

### BACKGROUND

Section 173.2500, RSMo, authorizes the Coordinating Board for Higher Education (CBHE) to approve certain postsecondary institutions as “approved dual credit providers.” To be considered for CBHE approval, public, private, or virtual Missouri higher education institutions, as defined in 173.1102, RSMo, are required to submit a list of high schools through which dual credit courses will be offered, the courses that will be offered at each school, and the cost per credit hour.

The approved dual credit provider list is used by the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education’s Missouri School Improvement Program as well as by the department financial aid staff to verify eligibility for the Dual Credit and Dual Enrollment Scholarship.

### CURRENT STATUS

In April 2024, institutions were notified to provide the required documentation for the 2024-2025 academic year. The attached list includes all eligible institutions that provided the documents prior to the publication of this board item. Per the CBHE’s decision to delegate authority at the September 2022 meeting, institutions unable to meet the deadline for this meeting or institutions requiring adjustments to the locations, courses, or costs throughout the year, may be included on the published list upon approval by the Commissioner of Higher Education, serving as the board’s designee.

### NEXT STEPS

Upon CBHE approval, staff will update the department’s website with the 2024-2025 Approved Dual Credit Provider list.

### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommend approval of the attached Dual Credit Provider List for publication on the department’s website.
