BACKGROUND

The First Regular Session of the 100th General Assembly began on January 9, 2019, and concludes on May 17, 2018. The last day to file new bills is March 1, 2019.

CURRENT STATUS

The attached Bill Tracking Report includes all bills filed as of February 26, 2019, that MDHE is following.

Paul Wagner, Executive Director of the Council on Public Higher Education, and Brian Millner, President/CEO of the Missouri Community College Association, will present an update on the 2019 legislative session during the board meeting.

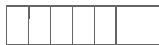
