PROPOSED CBHE-APPROVED MISSION DESCRIPTION

Missouri State University, located in Springfield, is a comprehensive university with a statewide mission in public affairs. Missouri State University is designated as a selective institution.

Missouri State University serves the state by offering baccalaureate and master's degrees in the arts and humanities, teacher education, agriculture, and the natural, health and social sciences appropriate to a teaching institution with a predominately undergraduate student body and a broad range of master's degrees. Missouri State also offers professional doctorate degrees in audiology, physical therapy, nursing practice and nurse anesthesia. Missouri State has particular strengths in business-related fields, agriculture, teacher education, environmental sciences and allied health disciplines.

Missouri State University also fulfills its mission by offering services to promote and sustain economic development, small business development, and workforce development, in addition to a broad range of academic and cultural activities and events.

Consistent with the provisions of 173.030(8) RSMo, Missouri State University every five years will provide to the Coordinating Board evidence of fulfilling its CBHE-approved mission.
