

Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment Scholarship

2022-2023 Academic Year

Eligibility

Old (spring 2022)

- U.S. citizen/permanent resident
- Enroll in eligible DCDE coursework at approved MO provider (list on website)
- Have met HS requirements for DCDE coursework, except GPA must have been:
 - 2.5 unweighted CGPA **in semester immediately preceding DCDE classes**
- **Attended an A+ HS for at least 2 years**
- **Met A+ good citizenship/unlawful use of drugs & alcohol requirement**

New (beginning fall 2022)

- U.S. citizen/permanent resident
- Enroll in eligible DCDE coursework at approved MO provider (list on website)
- Meet HS requirements for DCDE coursework, except GPA must be:
 - 2.5 unweighted CGPA **at time of first application**
- **Missouri resident**

Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment Scholarship 2022-2023 Academic Year

Process

Old (spring 2022)

- Students applied
- DHEWD reviewed apps & created HS rosters
- HS certified eligibility
- DHEWD processed HS certs, notified students, and created DCDE Provider rosters
- Providers certified eligibility & awards
- DHEWD processed Provider certs
- DHEWD disbursed funds to Providers
- Providers delivered funds to students

New (beginning fall 2022)

- Students apply
- DHEWD reviews apps, notifies students & creates Provider rosters
 - HS certification eliminated
- Providers certify eligibility & awards
- DHEWD process Provider certs
- DHEWD disburses funds to Providers
- Providers deliver funds to students

Fast Track

2022-2023 Academic Year

- Loan-related provisions removed
 - Truth in lending disclosures, self-certification forms, and promissory notes no longer required
 - Postsecondary institutions enrollment status reporting no longer required
 - Prior recipients released from promissory note obligations
 - 3 year employment and residency following graduation
 - No recipients entered repayment
- Recipients still required to report employment/residency for 3 years (trigger TBD since all other obligations eliminated)
- Disbursements initiated upon Provider's certification of eligibility/award

Fast Track

2022-2023 Academic Year

- Application revision
 - Inclusion of new providers/programs
 - Ability to upload tax return and military documentation
 - Removal of:
 - References
 - Application Disclosure
 - Self-Certification form
- Application available early fall 2022
 - Summer awards will be made retroactively

Bright Flight – 2023-2024

- ACT Score change for 2023 seniors
 - 32 to qualify in top 3% (was 31)
 - 31 to qualify in top 4th & 5th percentiles (was 30)
- Superscoring begins with 2023 seniors

deadline and statutory maximums
