

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




Unemployment rates have decreased but are unequal across subpopulations

Missouri FAFSA Goal = 60% of HS Seniors


Through July, **42.7%** of the class of 2024 has completed a FAFSA, just under the national average

• This is 4,000 fewer students than last year when 45% of seniors filed


